Moving on to New Jersey we were greeted with a wet welcome as Hurricane Ida brought tornadoes and flash floods. We experienced the Lord's protection as we were out driving that day and got home just an hour before the roads were closed. Three people died in the floods within a mile of our home.





In between the busyness of church and supporter visits and debriefs with TEAM, the Lord has given us pockets of rest and refreshment. The Lord provided a car to use and housing at the missionary cottage in Flemington, NJ. Calvary Baptist Church has graciously let us use this cottage every Home Assignment so it feels like "home". Carlos enjoys helping with the yardwork here. We've also enjoyed a boat ride past Barnegat Lighthouse and out to the Atlantic Ocean and a buggy ride in Amish country when we saw the Esther presentation at Sight and Sound in Lancaster, PA. Sharing time with friends and family that we haven't seen in a long time is so special! We got in 3 visits with my dad before his healthcare center closed to visitors due to Covid. Pray that we will be able to visit him more before we head south.







We have visited 7 churches so far. PRAY for safety and protection as we visit the remaining 9. In November and December, we will be in Georgia, South Carolina and Florida. While in South Carolina we will be able to spend time with our daughter, Raquel, and her husband. We plan to spend Christmas with Ana and family in Dallas. Then we head back up to NJ for dad's 91st birthday on January 8, 2022 and then we return to Mexico on January 11th.

Pray that as we share the theme "God will make a Way" that people will be encouraged and challenged in their faith journeys and be more intentional to share the Gospel with others.
